GENERAL INFORMATION BROCHURE REGARDING THE CHAMPIONSHIP IS GIVEN BELOW:

1. Reception

- Participating teams shall intimate or report to the Accommodation Incharge about the date and time of their arrival, well in advance
- CSJM University is situated on G.T. Road Near Kalyanpur approximately 15 Km, from Kanpur Railway Station/ Bus Stand Tempo (Vikram), Taxi, Auto Rickshaws etc. are easily available at both places. The Organizing Committee will not provide any transportation facility from accommodation to the venue.
- Reception counter will be available at Multipurpose Hall, CSJM University campus from 18th Feb, 2024 from 02:00 pm onwards.

2. Accommodation

Teams will be provided unfurnished rooms/halls inside/outside of the University Campus. Teams are requested to bring their own Locks & Keys for their own safety. ***Accommodation will be provided only one day prior to the commencement of the matches and are expected to vacate immediately if they fail to qualify for the next round.***

- Accommodation counter will be arranged at CSJM University. All the team managers are requested to contact the accommodation in-charges at the tournament venue.
- Each team will have to pay Rs.3000/- (Rupees Two Thousand Only) as caution deposit, which will be refunded at the time of departure of the team after adjusting to the cost of damages.
- Food facility is available at nearby & surroundings of the tournament venue. Teams should make their own arrangements for Fooding.
- **The University has a cafeteria/Hostel's Mess where fooding facilities are available as per the menu of the day, on its actual prices as requested/informed in advance (one day before).**

3. Manager's Meeting

- The meeting of the Managers will be held on 18th Feb, 2024 at 4.00 pm in the Multipurpose Hall, CSJM University Campus. All Team managers are requested to be present.
- Opening ceremony of the Tournament will be held at CSJM University Stadium on 19th Feb 2024 at 11:00am onwards.

4. Eligibility & Documents

The team Managers is requested to bring with them following documents:

- i. Eligibility Performa's Quadruplicate (Four Copies) typed in and signed by the competent Authority according to the AIU rules
- ii. Identify cards of the participants for the current session under the signatures of competent authority as per AIU rules without any cutting or over writing, DMC of matric and 10+2 (in case of under graduate classes) and that of matric 10+2 and graduate (in case of PG classes) duly attested the competent authority of their universities.
- iii. All players and officials are required to have their ADHAAR cards with them.
- iv. Participating universities must provide attested photocopies as required.

Incomplete Proforma will not be entertained No over-writing is permitted on the Performa unless attested by the competent authority.

5. Officiating Charges

- The Manager of every team should pay Rs.1500/- (Rupees One Thousand Five Hundred Only) per match as officiating charge to the organizing Secretary / Ground In-charge officers before the commencement of their match.
- **The matches will be played by S.G. (Club) Ball. All teams coaches/managers are hereby informed that they have to purchase it by Registration committee and must submit the ball one day before the commencement of the match.**
- Matches will be held on matting and turf as per the availability of grounds. Hence the teams are advised to play accordingly.
- The teams should be ready Forty five minutes before the commencement of their matches.
- The Manager / Coach will be requested to produce the ball and officiating fees receipt whenever asked by the umpire.

6. Competition Rule

- All matches will be played as per the Board of Control for Cricket in India (BCCI) as adapted by Association of Indian Universities (AIU), New Delhi.
- The Team Managers are requested to follow the match schedule strictly and arrange to report to their teams at least 30 minutes before the commencement of the match.

- **The Organizing Secretary reserves the right to make any changes in the programme and the venue, if necessary, which shall be final and binding on the participant teams.**
- A copy of the fixtures is enclosed.
- The team managers, coaches and players are requested to cooperate with the Organizing Secretary/Organizers/Match Officials for the smooth conduct of the tournament.
- Protest against any other nature in connection with conduct of sporting competitions shall be in writing and must reach the organizing secretary along with protest fee Rs.2000/- only within "Two Hours" of the conclusion of the concerned matches for consideration of the "Jury of Appeal" for an appropriate necessary action, then and there/on the spot, in this regard.

7. PLAYING CONDITION-25 OVERS

- All Matches are played on Knock-out Basis.
- A player should be in proper cricketing attire (white clothing & predominantly white shoes unless specified otherwise). The umpires are the sole authority in implementing the dress code. The Umpires shall ask the concerned player to leave the field if the dress code is not followed.
- On matting wickets use of spiked shoes by the bowlers and batsman is not permitted.
- All matches will be of one innings per side, each innings being limited to 25 Overs per side. Minimum 10 overs constitute a match in case of any interrupted matches.
- Declaration is not permitted.
- No bowler shall bowl more than 5 overs in an innings. In a delayed or interrupted match where the overs are reduced for both teams or for the team bowling second, no bowler may bowl more than one-fifth of the total overs allowed. Where the total overs are not divisible by 5, one additional over shall be allowed to the maximum number per bowler necessary to make up the balance.
- If a match is delayed or interrupted on account of ground, weather and light conditions, overs shall be reduced as one over for each four minutes lost.
- Free hit will be awarded for all types of No Balls. During Free hit, change of field/fieldsman is not permitted for the same striker.
- At the instant of delivery, there shall be not more than 5 field-men on the leg side and not more than 2 fielders behind the popping crease on the leg side.
- At the instant of delivery, there shall be not more than 5 field men outside the inner circle throughout the match.
- A bowler shall be limited to One fast short-pitched delivery per over. Subsequent short pitch deliveries in the same over shall be called No Ball
- Hours of Play

Match: 09.00 am -02.30am First Session

8. RESULT-25 OVERS

- Once the match begins and a team does not continue with the match it shall be considered as conceding the match.
- Absenting a team or only a certain number of players present and not filling the nomination form is considered as "walk over".
- When the match is called off without a ball being bowled and even minimum 10 overs for both the sides is not achieved the result will be decided by "SPIN OF COIN" by the captains in the presence of umpires.
- In case of a tie, the team which has lost a lesser number of wickets will be declared as the winner.
- In case of equality in the number of wickets lost, the result will be decided by "SPIN OF COIN" by the captains in presence of the umpires.
- In case the team batting second has the opportunity of playing 10 overs or more and is interrupted due to ground, weather and light conditions the result of the match is decided with the team having better run rate at that stage. (For Ex. If team A has scored 150 runs in allotted 25 overs (NRR=6.00), Team B had scored 100 runs in 20 overs (NRR=5.00). Team A wins the match by better Run rate.
- Umpire's decision will be final and binding. No appeal/protest against the umpire's decision are entertained.

NOTE: ALL TEAMS SHOULD REPORT TO THE GROUND 30 MINUTES BEFORE THE SCHEDULED TIME FOR THE START OF THE MATCH

9. PLAYING CONDITION-35 OVERS

- All Matches are played on Knockout Basis.
- A player should be in proper cricketing attire (white clothing & predominantly white shoes unless specified otherwise). The umpires are the sole authority in implementing the dress code. The Umpires shall ask the concerned player to leave the field if the dress code is not followed.
- On matting wickets use of spiked shoes by the bowlers and batsman is not permitted.
- All matches will be of one innings per side, each innings being limited to 35 Overs per side.

Minimum 10 overs constitute a match in case of any interrupted matches.

- Declaration is not permitted.
- No bowler shall bowl more than 7 overs in an innings. In a delayed or interrupted match where the overs are reduced for both teams or for the team bowling second, no bowler may bowl more than one-fifth of the total overs allowed. Where the total overs are not divisible by 5, one additional over shall be allowed to the maximum number per bowler necessary to make up the balance.
- If a match is delayed or interrupted on account of ground, weather and light conditions, overs shall be reduced as one over for each four minutes lost.
- Free hit will be awarded for all types of No Balls. During Free hit, change of field/fieldsman is not permitted for the same striker.
- Power play from 0-07 overs and Non-power play from 08-35 overs are implemented from quarterfinals. Subject to ground, weather and light if the number of overs is reduced for the match, power play overs will be accordingly reduced by the umpires and will be informed to both captains at the toss.
- During the power play overs from 0-07, at instant of delivery there shall not be more than two field men outside the inner circle, during non-power play overs from 08-35, there shall not be more than five field men outside the inner circle.
- At the instant of delivery there shall be not more than 5 field man on the leg side and not more than 2 fielders behind the popping crease on the leg side.
- A bowler shall be limited to Two fast short-pitched delivery per over. Subsequent short pitch deliveries in the same over shall be called No Ball

10. RESULT

- Once the match begins and a team does not continue with the match it shall be considered as conceding the match.
- Absenting a team or only a certain number of players present and not filling the nomination form is considered as “walk over”.
- When the match is called off without a ball being bowled and even minimum 15 overs for both the sides is not achieved the result will be decided by “SPIN OF COIN” by the captains in the presence of umpires.
- In case of a tie, the team which has lost a lesser number of wickets will be declared as the winner. In case of
- Equality in number of wickets lost, the result will be decided by “SPIN OF COIN” by the captains in presence of the umpires.
- In case the team batting second has the opportunity of playing 10 overs or more and is interrupted due to ground, weather and light conditions the result of the match is decided with the team having better net run rate at that stage. (For Ex. If team A has scored 270 runs in allotted 45 overs (NRR=6.00), Team B had scored 150 runs in 30 overs (NRR=5.00). Team A wins the match by better Run rate.
- Umpire’s decision will be final and binding. No appeal/protest against the umpire’s decision are entertained.

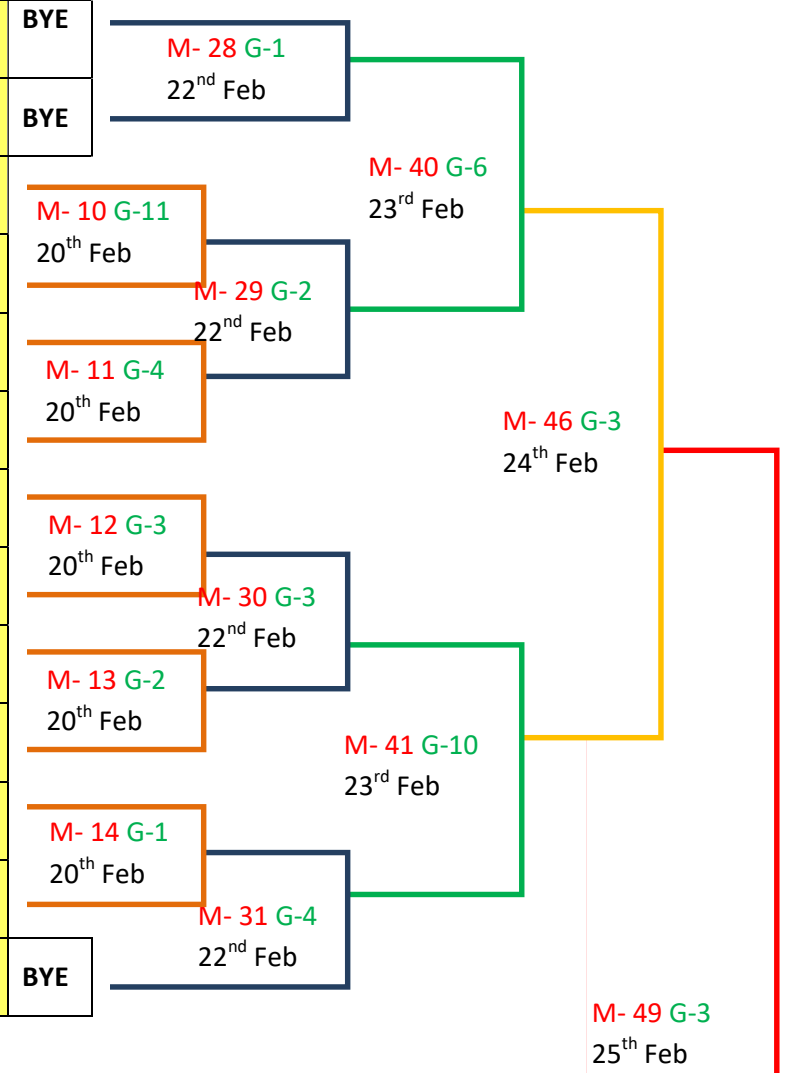

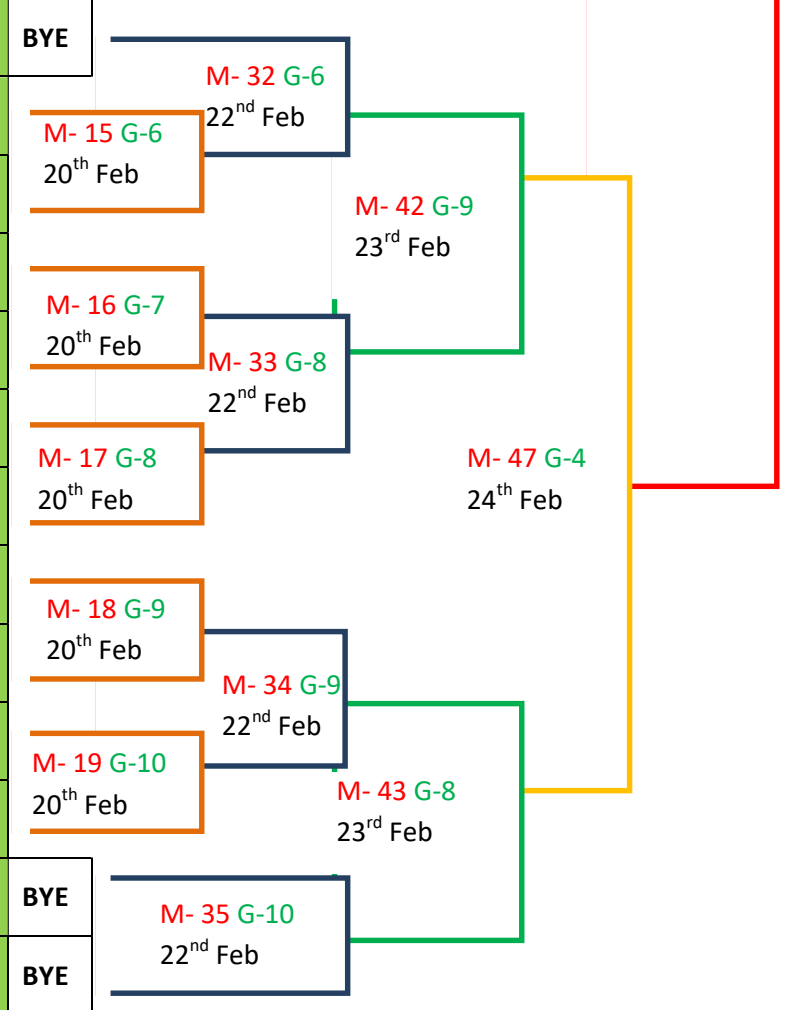
