Mental health is a crucial part of overall well-being, as it affects how we think, feel, and act in our daily lives. It influences how we handle stress, relate to others, and make choices. Good mental health enables individuals to cope with the challenges of life, work productively, and contribute to their communities. When mental health is neglected, it can lead to serious issues like anxiety, depression, and other emotional disorders, which may impact physical health and quality of life. Prioritizing mental health through self-care, support systems, and professional help when needed is essential for leading a balanced and fulfilling life.

Chhatrapati Shahu Ji Maharaj University (CSJMU) in Kanpur offers a comprehensive range of psychological services to support the mental health and well-being of its students, faculty, and staff. The university's Counselling Cell provides confidential counselling and therapy sessions facilitated by trained professionals, aiming to address various mental health concerns and promote emotional well-being.

In addition to counselling services, **CSJM University has established (January, 2025) a Centre for Well-Being** to proactively address student and university staff's mental health. This initiative focuses on supporting students dealing with depression and self-harm tendencies, reflecting the university's commitment to fostering a supportive environment.

Comprehensive Mental Health Counselling Action Plan at CSJM University:

CSJM University is committed to promoting the mental well-being of its students under the School of Arts, Humanities and Social Sciences. The objective and priority of the current programme is to lift mental health of the university 'students and increase coping and problem-solving behaviour in students. The

main objective of the program will be to screen out students who are at the high risk of maladaptive behaviour like suicide, impulsivity and other disruptive behaviour. This Program will be enormously advantageous for students of the university.

Counselling Aims:

- To discuss mental health issues and enhance coping behaviour among students.
- To screen students for risk behaviour related to depression, anxiety, impulsivity and suicidal ideation.
- To provide detailed case histories followed by focused problem-solving counselling sessions.
- To refer students to a psychiatrist for pharmacological treatment if required.
- To conduct regular follow up by counselling team members.

Step by Step Action Plan for Individual Counselling session at OPD level:

1. Sociodemographic details of the client will be taken.
2. Informed Consent will be taken from the client.
3. Detail Case history will be taken.
4. Required psychological assessment will be done for deeper understanding of the individual.
5. Needful Counselling sessions will be held according to the severity of symptoms.
6. If needed case will be referred to the Psychiatrist panel. Family members will include in this stage to enhance compliance behaviour and to create supportive environment.
7. Regular follow up will be done by the counselling centre of CSJM University.

Ethical Considerations:

- **Informed consent** will be taken before counselling.
- **Confidentiality** will be maintained.
- Counselling process will be **beneficence** and **non-maleficence**.
- Data will be used only for official purpose.
- In case of any threatening condition confidentiality can be broken to family members/ competent authority.

5. Improved mental health and well-being of students through continuous support and follow-up.

By implementing this comprehensive Mental Health Counselling Action Plan, CSJM University aims to create a supportive and proactive environment for addressing mental health challenges. This program will not only educate students but also provide critical data for developing long-term mental health support systems on campus.
