#### सारांश

Mathematical Intelligences is an ability to use make effectively and high reasoning power, Napula intelligence is an ability to recognize and classifity species- the flora and fauna and it include sension towards natural phenomenon. Spatial intelligence is for capacity to think in pictures to apprehend the visual and precisely. Bodily-kinesthetic intelligence is an ablive use the whole body and parts to efficiently sale in problems. Musical intelligence is the capacity to percit recognize, discriminate, transform and express mess? forms. Interpersonal intelligence is an ability to undersail others people moods, feelings, desires, motivator of gestures effectively. Intrapersonal intelligence is a capall to understand one's own emotions, feelings, strength al weaknesses. Existential intelligence deal with the ultraft life issues about existence. Gardner suggested that the amount of each intelligence is different in each individual and these intelligences can be sharpened to an optimal level through proper and appropriate training in interview with Kathy Checkley (1997), Gardner and very important that a teacher take individual different among kids very seriously.
