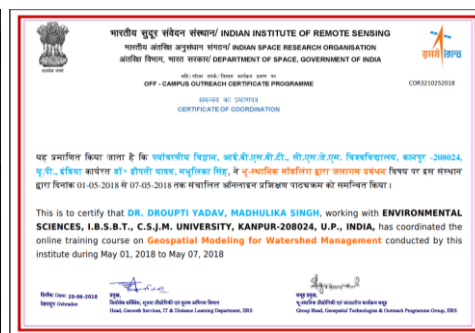
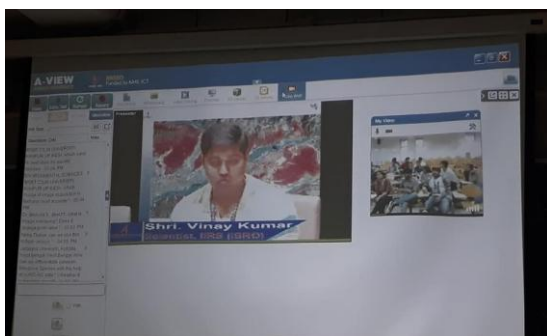


WORKSHOP ON IIRS-ISRO OUTREACH PROGRAM
