The webinar titled "Challenges in Journalism During Pandemic" was conducted by Dr. Govind Kumar of Jammu University on 30 April, 2020 for the faculty and students of the Institute of Journalism and mass communication to shed light on the difficulties faced by journalists in reporting during the pandemic.

The key speaker of the webinar discussed the ethical dilemmas faced by reporters, such as balancing the public's right to know with patient confidentiality, and the need to verify information amidst the proliferation of fake news propagating on the Internet and traditional news media.

Dr. Kumar also highlighted the increased risk faced by journalists in the field, particularly in regions with limited access to personal protective equipment. He also emphasized the importance of prioritizing mental health and self-care, given the high stress and anxiety levels associated with covering the pandemic.

Overall, the webinar provided valuable insights into the challenges faced by journalists during the ongoing global crisis.
