



Incremental improvements made for the preceding five years with regard to quality (in case of first cycle), Post accreditation quality initiatives (second and subsequent cycles)

Suggestions made in the previous accreditation cycle have been successfully implemented by the University. The same have been discussed as under:

1. **Curricular Aspects:** The University follows the established protocol in designing and implementation of the curricula. BOS has been held for almost all programs running in the University, leading to a revision in curriculum. This revision is systematically based on the feedback taken from all stakeholders, and on the recommendations of experts in academia. There are a range of interdisciplinary courses and job oriented courses running across all programs. Semester system has been adopted. A total of 92 programmes are being offered at UG and PG levels. Choice Based Credit System (CBCS)/Electives(ECS) has been introduced in all programs. In sync with the NEP, students are given the opportunity of credit accumulation and transfer. The members of the faculty are encouraged to enrich the teaching experience by the use of ICT tools. Value Added Courses have been introduced in all Schools (formerly Departments).

2. **Teaching – Learning & Evaluation:** The entire admission process has been digitalized, with all relevant data made available on the University website, leading to complete transparency. The admission policy of the University and the affiliated colleges concur with the government and the other statutory bodies' regulations.

The University organizes orientation / fresher programs for all new students. The University has a Mentor-Mentee system which enables the faculty members to identify fast and slow learners. Remedial classes are provided to slow learners, along with providing counseling services. The fast learners are encouraged to explore interdisciplinary course, so as to help them tap into their maximum potential.

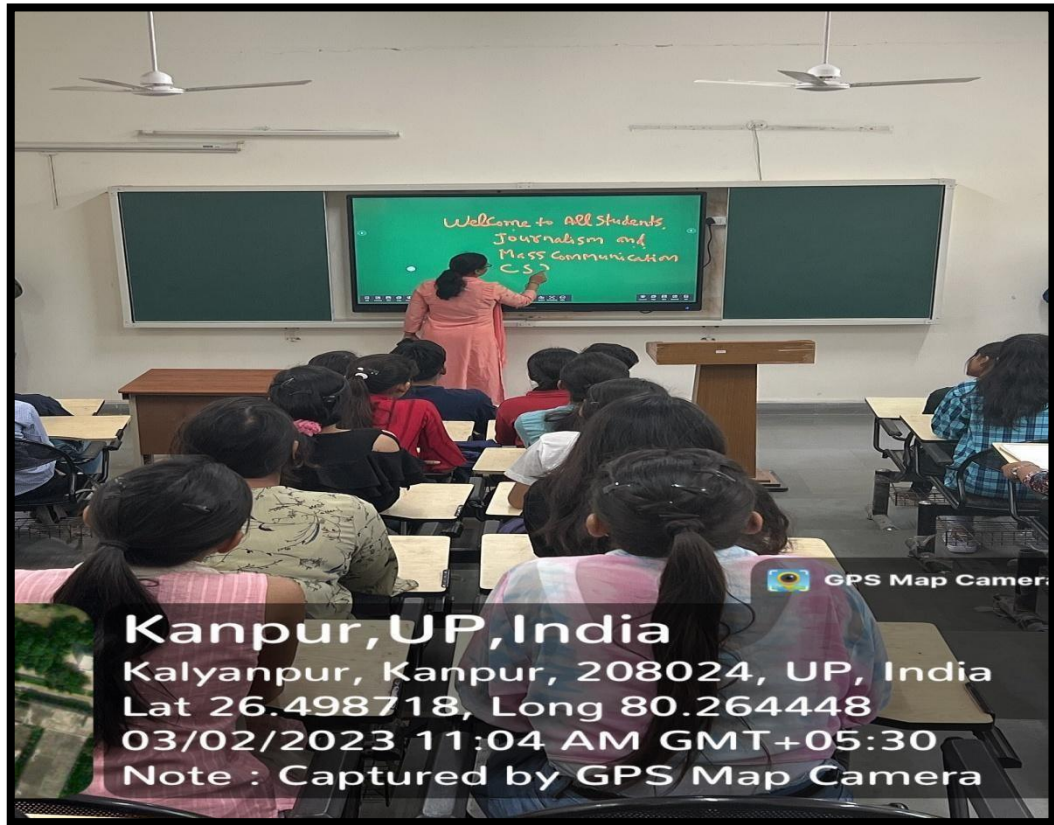
An academic calendar is made available to the students at the outset of each academic session. 95% of classes are ICT enabled. The e-learning portal, GyanSanchay was successfully launched and today it is a repertoire of lecture notes, discussion videos, etc. The practical and filed based experiential learning is offered to the students by the virtue of a range of MOU's that the University has signed with the Industry.

With an intent to improve the student faculty ratio a faculty-recruitment drive was undertaken and 137 teachers were appointed for aided and SFS departments, along with promotion of several existing faculty members. The faculty members regularly undertake FDP's to enhance the teaching and learning quality. The attainment level of each course is based on COPO analysis. The number of faculty members receiving awards and recognitions has significantly improved.

3. **Teaching, Consultancy, and Extension:** The University offers autonomy to Schools and the evaluation process has been digitalized. A huge number of scholars have been enrolled in PhD program, along with a significant number of students undertaking research at PG levels. One Biotechnology lab has been established and an Animal House facility is created. Faculty members and students are encouraged to publish quality research in reputed journals with high impact factor. This number has potentially improved since the last accreditation cycle.

University is actively involved in Extension activities which help in imparting the knowledge and skills developed through research and education and making them available to the wider community. It helps the students to come close to the nature. Extension activities in the University motivates and sensitized students to social issues and holistic development.

The University's research infrastructure facilities have been significantly improved. The University has also established various mandatory / statutory committees for promotion of research consultancy. The University generates revenue through consultancy. The University has successfully initiated formal collaborations / MoU's with national organizations.

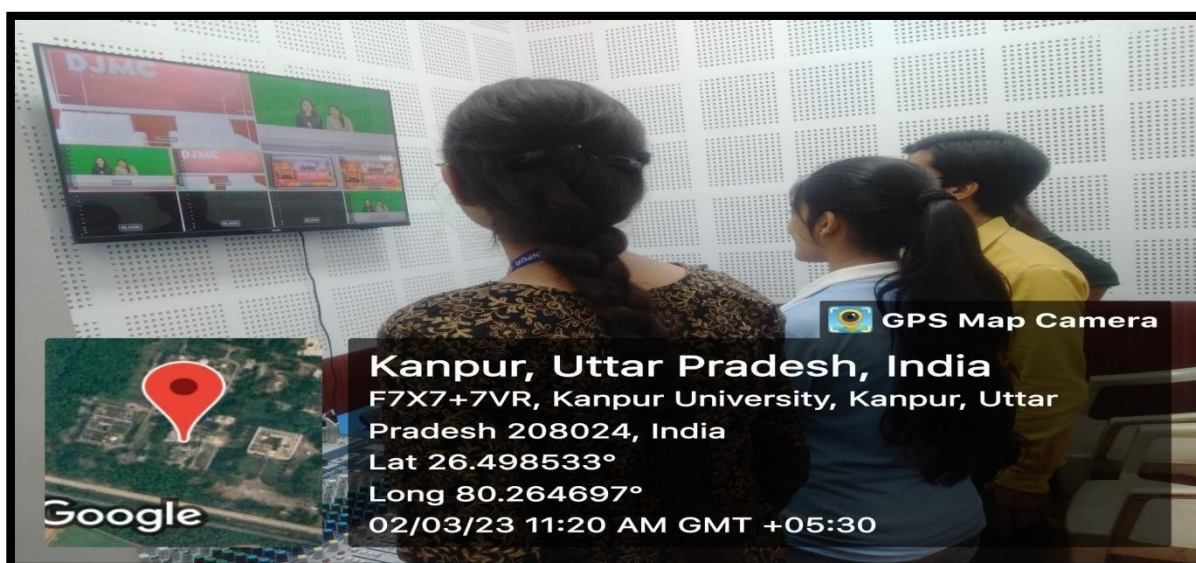

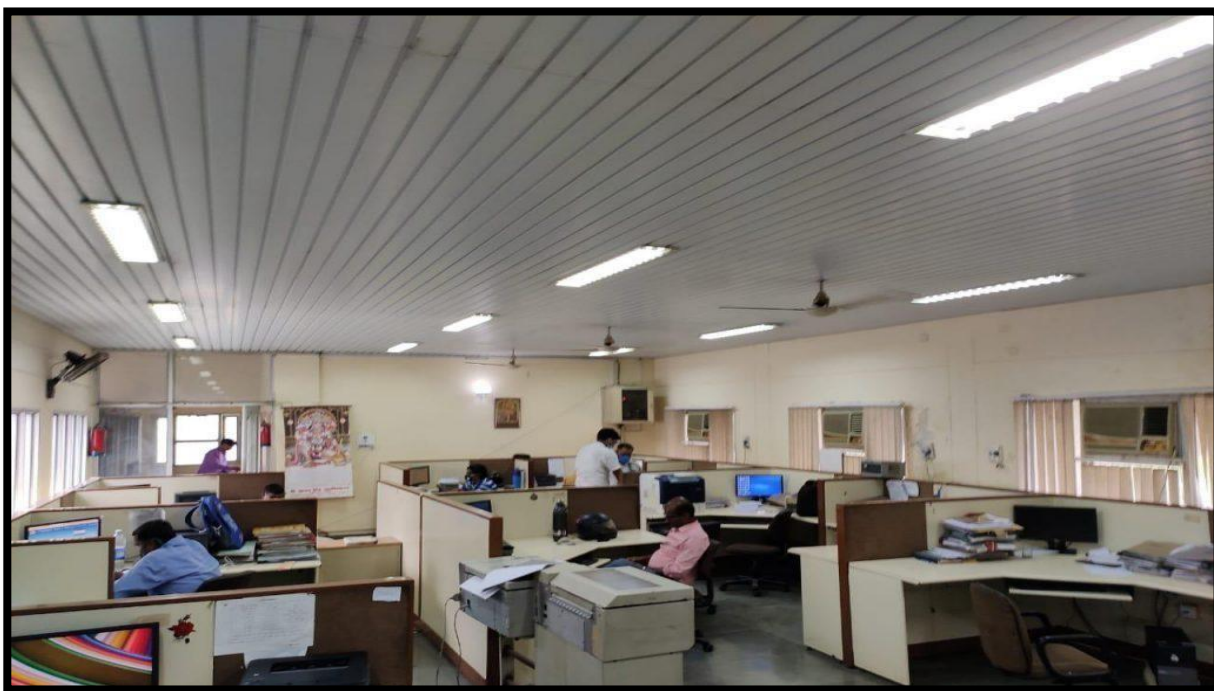
4. **Infrastructure and Learning Resources:** The University now has two boys' hostels and four girls' hostel. The Library repertoire has undergone significant increase. The University has procured a huge number of text and critical books. The Library is now also available on e-Library App. Latest Software has been procured in the different schools to facilitate ICT learning. The WI-FI facility is now available throughout the campus, including the students' hostels. **An Audio Visual Lab for Person With Disability (PWD)** has been created to cater the information need of the physically challenged person. Best Practice – 01

a- Title: Health Care Services to the Society

b- Objective:

There is a need to provide the finest health care services to the downtrodden and the weaker sections of the society. It is CSJMU's mission to provide better access to health services, reduce health care costs, hold regular health camps and improve medical care and resources in rural and remote areas. This practice also ensures access to better medical care and resources for the campus community. To provide medical care to the community at a very low cost, the university has developed a state-of-the-art health system. Facilities include:

1. A well-equipped 10-bedded health centre is available to students, employees, and citizens of Kanpur at the Health Centre.
2. A pathology, automation, and microbiology lab with pathologist-supervised facilities is available at very low cost that covers more than 120 pathological investigations.
3. Minor OT, 24x7 ambulance service, ECG and Multipara monitor services are available at the health centre.
4. School of Health Sciences also offers Physiotherapy at an extremely affordable price with their well-equipped outpatient department. A wide range of modalities is offered, including manual therapy, electrotherapy, hydrotherapy, and exercise therapy.

5. Free nutritional consultations and diet charts are provided at School of Health Sciences for patients suffering from various diseases.

These medical services allow patients to get the care they need at a lower cost. This not only saves money, but also provides access to quality healthcare to those who might not otherwise have it. Furthermore, the physiotherapy outpatient department provides specialized care for patients in need, so they receive the best possible management.

b- Objectives of the practice-

The Anganwadi Sahbhagita programme at CSJMU is an excellent community outreach service motivated by a goal to support the existing Anganwadi centres.
