



Convocation Address of the Chief Guest

The Science Education in India, Catch them young

Hon'ble Chancellor of the University, Your Excellency Smt. Anandiben Patel Ji, Respected Vice-Chancellor Prof. Neelima Gupta Ji, Distinguished Yoga Guru, Dr. H. R. Nagendra Ji, the *Honoris Causa* Awardee, Esteemed Guest of Honour, Smt. Nilima Katiyar Ji, the Minister of State for Education in Government of U.P., Learned Members of the Academic Council, Executive Council, my dear students, Ladies and Gentlemen.

Education globally is influenced by the Environment as well as employability and opportunities. In our time the parents either wanted their children to be a Doctor, Engineer or a Lawyer. Those who missed the opportunities went for pure science or biological sciences. A very few children took up Economics, Commerce, Mathematics, Business Management, Literature / History etc since the other employment opportunities were not known and private education both in the area of medicine, engineering and Universities had not opened up. Few privileged went for administrative services. Currently, the science education has become very unattractive without PhD, the job opportunity remains scarce and those who are not of top quality, the value of their PhD remains doubtful. Hence, India harbors large number of unemployed PhDs. Again the science is a hard grind and even after completing the education

average age of the person ready for employment is much higher than those who opt for humanities and non-science subjects and they get very large number of cross opportunities which are not open to Science Graduates. Hence, huge crisis has emerged as even those who become doctors and engineers and if their quality is not good, simple MBBS degree does not take them anywhere. Half of the engineering seats remain vacant and again the quality is crisis. Some of the top graduates in Engineering after doing MBA do not practice their vocation but may sell soap and go to the banking or finance and other sectors. Hence, it leads to big crisis and vacuum in Science education. I was educated in this city after I came as a refugee from Multan / Lahore and studied in Government Higher Secondary schools and BNSD Inter College. Both provided education in language and science with very high quality teachers. The students came from all walks of life, very poor and very well to do families. Hence, our language communication skill as well as the Science education were of the quality which paved my way in reaching the highest ladder of life and I will like to remind that our financial situation was very poor as a refugee. I paid minimal fee. I again came to Kanpur University for a Honoris Causa D.Sc. degree and visited my old schools. There were tears in my eyes when I saw their condition. Private Education has burgeoned and most of the well to do families prefer to study there. I remember when I was in School I read Bernard Shaw, Hans Christian Anderson, Chaucer, Thomas Hardy, Emil Zola and Simon de Beauvoir etc of course. I also read Louis Fischer's Gandhi and Discovery of India. I do not know whether children of these times read these books, hence my English and communication was tolerable and I learnt reasonable mathematics. These were important means for moving forward.

In today's world there is a crisis in Science and education, 300 million extremely poor children have no choice. Their education remains incomplete without skills in language, in Mathematics as well as in modern tools of communication such as reasonable IT usage. The poorest of the poor child, if given access, gets an opportunity and a chance to perform with the best of their age and their mind gets ignited. This is the group which should opt for Science. However, they don't get a chance because the Government school lack standard and private schools are out of their reach particularly at the village level or sub district level. The most hit is the girl child. Education does not mean the ability to sign. It means much more. Recently skill assessment of Indian School Children of several states have been made and we find their skill set in Science, Languages and Mathematics are poor. In education we should invest at the lowest rung of our education system. There should be a robust partnership of State and Center. The

infrastructure needs to be upgraded to the best and teachers' salaries and their acumens need also to be of the best category. Indeed, it is in the realm of possibility. In Cuba basics of education is very strong and benefits filter to lowest level of beneficiaries. Somebody put a computer in Mumbai slum and the children themselves learnt how to use the computer, similarly Khan Academy brought mathematics to the children's home through distant education. A good Samaritan in Bihar trained poor children to qualify for Indian Administrative Service, and they all did well. The skills in languages are learnt very early by children.

Apart from their mother tongue, if they learnt English including writing and communication skills they will benefit hugely in their life. A good language teacher will be able to do that. There are several models for this and one of the model is KISS University in Bhubaneshwar where 25000 children are provided quality education. While they are learning they also earn through art, handicraft, carpentry, music and sports earning from which goes into their account and thereby they contribute to family's wealth also. Could we utilize Setu Programme more efficiently with university teachers and researchers interacting with children from government schools so that they get a taste of quality education, research and innovation. I have seen how the children from very poor families use the 3 D printing to provide Innovative designs or have solved common day problems by innovating in designs and execution. I myself do a programme where I provide school children some information in a science topic and 10-15 children from schools along with their teachers are invited and two of their representative make a presentation. I observed that each child processes the information and adds on their own innovation and communicate it in their own fashion. It is not for and against debate, it is the same information being processed and communicated individually.

Everyone listens with much more attention than what happens in classes. Although many countries teach in Vernacular languages like Thailand, Iran, China etc but they have quality books in the science subjects. They are also taught either English, French or German which is creating future generation of global citizens. The five Asian Giants Taiwan, Singapore, South Korea, Thailand, Malaysia invested in their children's education and they became engines of growth.

Hence, education is not a wasteful expenditure, Education is an investment for analysis, development and economic growth and also creating future citizens who are useful. We should also do in depth that how our education system should go, whether everyone after graduation should go for research and

higher education or some of them acquire new skill sets in engineering and manufacturing to earn healthy income and contribute to the nation's growth and only those who can handle higher education move towards that with full support of state through scholarships. The education loan is a crippling instrument particularly for the poor and they are not able to return it and hence can not move to the next step. I will look for the better method to finance education of poor children. The best method is to teach them how to fish rather than providing free fish to eat. They need to be taught skills of survival and sustenance. They also need to be taught the values, ethics as well as compassion. No child is intellectually inferior whether he comes from a poor background or from poor social ladder. Hence, creating an environment which excites them and provides for an opportunity for learning and growth will ultimately lead into products who are equal. The universities have a huge responsibility to participate in these missions. They should adopt villages and the schools in their own locality and with their huge students and teacher workforce could create our future citizens. I am not speaking of a socialist revolution but speaking of creating social structure which is full of opportunities, hope and prosperity with a sense of participation in the nation building. Let us not divide our children in various categories and segments. Each child is an asset and treasure. The founder of the SOS movement when asked that why you invest in children, his answer was the children are the most beautiful thing and they give you the joy which nobody else can give. Hence, all of us who were given opportunity by this nation, should give it back to the underprivileged and help them proudly join the main stream.

He is now the Chancellor of S-VYASA Deemed University. He is a recipient of Yoga Shri title from the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare. Dr. H. R. Nagendra has authored 35 books and over 100 research

papers on Yoga. The Government of India awarded him the civilian honour of the Padma Shri in 2016, for his contributions to the society. Dr. H. R. Nagendra, is widely recognized across the world as Yoga Guru. Dr. Nagendra inaugurated the Yoga Centre recently in the University Campus on 19th August, 2019 and showed the University how a combination of yoga postures can help to alleviate occupational stress and treat diseases like asthma, cancer and psychiatric illnesses. Owing to its 'Quest for Excellence', it is continuously monitoring and upgrading its knowledge resources with improved focus on faculty, curriculum, admissions, examinations and evaluation. Digitalisation and uploading of Ph.D. theses is under process, around 2000 theses have been digitalized and are being uploaded on the Shodh Ganga Portal.
- Digital payment modes are mandatory in all kinds of payments. Online fee transfer has been adopted.
- ❖ The admissions for the session 2019-20 have been completed by admitting 2,65,236 students in affiliating colleges and 2098 in the campus. All students admitted have compulsorily generated their Web Registration Number (WRN) and classes are in full swing.
