

3. With a view to expose teachers and researchers of our University to the learning and research environment IQAC proposed Faculty Development programme on Research Methodology but in online method.


4. Proposal was given for promoting research culture by organizing Conferences/Workshop/STTP etc, in various departments for students and teachers online.
