About CSJM University:

Chhatrapati Shahu Ji Maharaj University, Kanpur (herein after referred as CSJM University Kanpur) was established in 1966, with 952 affiliated colleges in 7 districts. It is spread over an area of 264 acres, with undergraduate and post-graduate program in all disciplines of Arts, Science, Life Science, Biotechnology, Management, Commerce, Law, Engineering and Medicine being run on campus. The CSJM University is striving to create and develop ecosystem of opportunities for career building and entrepreneurship not only for its existing students but also for its alumni. School of Business Management was established in year 1991 to meet the demand of trained management graduates in the light of ongoing liberalization and globalization. The Institute has been running two-year full time post graduate program in Business Administration since 1991. Institute is also running Ph.D. Program in Management since its inception.

About MoU:

Representatives of Chhatrapati Shahu Ji Maharaj University, Kanpur and Regency Institute of Nursing, Kanpur have discussed the desirable and feasibility of an interactive relationship designed to strengthen the bonds between two institutions. This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is intended to run Masters in Hospital Administration (MHA) Program in collaboration with Regency Institute of Nursing (Unit of Regency Hospital Ltd., Kanpur) for research collaboration and exchange of knowledge as described in the objectives listed below. Both Chhatrapati Shahu Ji Maharaj University, Kanpur and Regency Institute of Nursing, Kanpur are also referred to herein as "Institution" or, collectively, Institutions.

I

Objectives:

The objective of MoU for full time Four-Semester Post-Graduate **Degree MHA** programme, to be jointly conducted by Chhatrapati Shahu Ji Maharaj University, Kanpur and Regency Institute of Nursing (A Unit of Regency Hospital Ltd.), Kanpur is-

- To impart the fundamentals of Hospital administration for development of effective and adequate second line of leadership in management of hospitals and other health organisations in this era of rapidly expanding Health sector.
- To develop knowledge, skills and attitude among the learners for managing material and human resource systems in hospitals.
- To equip the learners with leadership and business fundamentals in classroom environment on one hand and to give opportunity to use such knowledge in industrial setting on the other.
- To provide for an industry led, practice oriented and outcome-based learning.
- To foster a collaborative relationship and establish a partnership for promoting mutual cooperation and support to both the institutions.
- To promote/encourage the students and faculty in programs for the mutual benefits of both institutions.
- To utilize the academic and research facilities in both institutions.
- By joint efforts students, research scholar and faculty from both institutions may apply for collaborative projects jointly to national and international funding agencies.
- To facilitate working together on various academic and research techniques for development of both institutions.
- To support the visit of students and faculty for purpose of academics, clinical training, research and publications.
- To facilitate the cultural and intellectual enrichment opportunities for the faculty and students of both institutions.

- To facilitate the collaborative faculty development program and to organize symposia, conference, workshop and seminars by the joint of both institutions.
- The scientific/faculty members of both the institutions may be included as resource persons for delivering lectures/talk on specialized topic in different academic and scientific program.
- To share educational resources, including library materials, online databases, research facilities, and technological infrastructure, to enhance the educational experience and promote efficiency.
- To benefit students by mutual experiences.

This collaboration will provide the much-needed support and resources for the development of skilled workforce. Upon completion of MHA programme, students will be able to play an effective managerial role and provide leadership in public and private hospitals and healthcare organizations.

II

ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

The MOU shall be effective from the date of approval by the appropriate authorities of both institutions. The student will attend their teaching learning for Masters in Hospital Administration program.

A) Broad Areas for Cooperation

CSJMU and Regency Institute of Nursing will cooperate in the following areas:

- i. Admission and Number of seats in the MHA Programme.
- ii. Internship- based learning.
- iii. Curriculum design with specific learning outcomes and allocation of faculty.
- iv. Mutual sharing of academic resources.
- v. Academic and research partnership.
- vi. Total credits assigned and award of degree.
- vii. Tuition Fee sharing
- viii. Continuous monitoring of learning outcomes through a Steering committee.

B) Responsibilities of CSJM University

CSJM University shall

1. Constitute a new Board of Studies for MHA (Master of Hospital Administration) programme with representation of Regency Institute of Nursing in accordance with university guidelines.
2. Design curriculum, fee structure and admission process for MHA (Master of Hospital Administration) programme through Board of Studies in consultation with Regency Institute of Nursing and seek approval from statutory bodies of the university.
3. Display admission notification on the Admission portal of CSJMU for registration by applicants.
4. Assist in classroom teaching in relevant areas prescribed in the curriculum bearing financial loads.
5. Lay down guidelines for examination and award of credits.
6. Permit use of infrastructural and other resources such as library services and hostel facility as per university regulations to the students.
7. Allow sharing of tuition fee per student admitted, after approval from the statutory body (Subject to approval from finance committee), tentatively in the ratio 40:60 with 40 percent share accruing to the university and 60 percent to Regency Institute of Nursing and transfer of the agreed share in the manner prescribed by the university (Annexure attached).
8. Award the degree as per University rules.

C) Responsibilities of Regency Institute of Nursing (A Unit of Regency Hospital Ltd.)

Regency Institute of Nursing shall

1. Display admission notification on its website for registration by applicants with proper acknowledgement of collaboration with CSJM University.
2. Abide by the financial commitments approved by the university.
3. Provide for physical amenities and arrange qualified professional for skill development and internship.
4. Deliver training in the form of workshops, hands-on-training, live projects, capacity building, panel discussion, brainstorming sessions, on-the-job training, internship or apprenticeship.
5. Provide learning material wherever required.
6. Facilitate faculty members from the university in academic affairs.
7. Enable students to develop state of the art skills, fund and encourage innovation and provide placement support to all MHA students.
8. Provide visiting faculty in relevant disciplines bearing financial loads.

D) Implementation and Monitoring:

1. The university and Regency Institute of Nursing shall appoint Programme coordinator to coordinate the programme on its behalf.
2. For proper implementation of the agreed objectives, the university shall constitute a steering committee comprising of representatives from School of Business Management, School of Health Science and Regency Institute of Nursing. The steering committee will review the progress of the collaboration in its periodic meetings and give suggestions if required.
3. CSJM University and Regency Institute of Nursing shall mutually acknowledge the contribution of each other, wherever possible, on their website and media platforms including print, TV and digital media.
4. Any amendment in this MoU will be made in writing by mutual consent of both the parties.

III

TERMINATION:

Either institution may terminate this MOU at any time without any explanation of the cause giving three (3) months written notice to the other. The minimum prescribed number of students for running the course shall be 10 (Ten). Upon termination the provision of this MOU and corresponding program agreements shall continue to apply to ongoing activities until each is complete, upto maximum of one (1) year from the effective date of termination.

IV

INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY, OWNERSHIP & PROTECTION:

All right and title to sole Intellectual Property (such as patent/copyright/trademark etc.) shall belong to the Party whose faculties invented, developed, created or discovered such sole Intellectual Property. Both Institutions shall promptly and fully disclose and Joint or Sole Intellectual Property developed by that University's employees, such disclosures to be maintained as confidential.

The lead institution for a particular research/project shall initiate in preparing and filing the joint Intellectual Property Rights. At the time of designation of a lead institution shall enter into an inter-institutional agreement that specifies the rights and obligations of the Universities in protecting and commercializing such Joint Intellectual Property.

ARBITRATION:


Any controversy or claim arising out of or the breach thereof, shall be settled by arbitration administered by Chhatrapati Shahu Ji Maharaj University, Kanpur and Regency Health Group Ltd., Kanpur. The place of arbitration shall be Kanpur, Uttar Pradesh law shall apply. Judgement on the award rendered by the arbitrator(s) may be entered in any court having jurisdiction Kanpur thereof.


VI




