

Memorandum of Understanding

and

Sankalp Special School, Kanpur

1. Background

Sankalp Special School, running as a project of Asha Trust, Kanpur chapter started in January 2007 with an aim to provide all the essential facilities to special children under one roof for their maximum growth. Asha is a charitable trust registered with the office of sub-registrar, Asaf Ali road, new Delhi with registration number 1316/4 dated 27/03/1992. Sankalp Special School from Kanpur is a Special School. They work with children and adults with Autism, Down Syndrome, Cerebral Palsy and other intellectual and developmental disabilities.

2. Purpose and Scope

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) establishes a framework for collaboration between Chhatrapati Shahu Ji Maharaj University (CSJMU), Kanpur, and Sankalp Special School, Kanpur. The partnership aims to integrate education, training, and community outreach to support the holistic development of students, faculty, and professionals in the field of psychology, special education, and rehabilitation sciences.

3. Objectives of the MoU

- a. To provide clinical exposure and hands-on training for CSJMU students in psychology, special education, and rehabilitation sciences.
- b. To facilitate joint research and academic collaborations on Children with special needs.
- c. To offer internship and training opportunities for CSJMU students at Sankalp Special School.
- d. To organize joint workshops, conferences, and awareness programs on special education and psychological well-being.
- e. To support community outreach programs promoting inclusivity and accessibility for special children.

4. Responsibilities of CSJMU

CSJMU will:

- a. Nominate students for practical training, internships, and clinical exposure at Sankalp Special School, Kanpur.
- b. Facilitate faculty exchange and collaborative research in special education and rehabilitation.
- c. Organize joint awareness campaigns and training programs on child development and disabilities.
- d. Ensure students follow ethical guidelines and professional standards in rehabilitation services.

5. Responsibilities of Sankalp Special School

Sankalp Special School will:

- a. Provide internship and hands-on training to CSJMU students under expert supervision.
- b. Offer access to vocational training facilities for student learning.
- c. Collaborate on joint research, curriculum development, and academic projects related to special children.
- d. Assist in organizing seminars, workshops, and community engagement programs.

6. Confidentiality and Compliance

- a. Both institutions will ensure strict confidentiality of patient and student data.
- b. The partnership will adhere to government regulations, RCI norms, and ethical guidelines in rehabilitation and education.
- c. Any research involving children will require ethical clearance from relevant authorities.

7. Financial and Administrative Terms

- a. This MoU does not create any financial liabilities unless agreed upon in separate projectspecific agreements.
- b. Funding for joint research, training programs, or infrastructure development will be sought through mutual proposals.
- c. Administrative responsibilities will be handled by designated coordinators from both institutions.

8. Legal and Liability Clause

- a. This MoU is a non-binding agreement and does not impose any legal or financial obligations.
- b. Any disputes will be resolved through mutual consultation between the institutions.
- c. Legal jurisdiction, if required, will fall under the courts of Kanpur, Uttar Pradesh.

9. Duration and Termination

- a. This MoU shall remain in effect for five (5) years from the date of signing.
- b. Either party may terminate this agreement with a 90-day written notice, ensuring the completion of ongoing activities.
- c. The MoU may be renewed or modified based on mutual agreement.

10. Signatories

This agreement is signed in good faith by authorized representatives of both institutions.
