#### **PREAMBLE**

We encourage our students to take part in Co-Curricular, Extra-Curricular, Extension and other cultural activities.

The associations of eleven Schools offered in the institution act as a platform for the students in organizing many co-curricular activities to exhibit their creative talents and inner potentials in their respective disciplines.

#### UNIVERSITY UNION & AFFILIATED ASSOCIATIONS

The University union is the main organization of the student body of the college. It consists of:

#### Selection of Union Members

The Student Chairman, Secretary, and the Joint Secretary are selected by the staff council.

The Students Chairman and Secretary will be selected from the final year classes only.

The Joint Secretary will be selected from the second year classes.

The union operates through the main committee, a sub-Committee of secretaries of all the affiliated associations under the patronage of the Director/Dean/Head who is the Ex-Officio President of the union. Two senior members of the teaching faculty nominated by the respective schools are the advisers of the union.

#### Sports and Extra-Curricular Activities:

Study and sports are two linked components of our learning process and will always be important for an individual. A healthy mind can exist only in a healthy body. It is rightly said that a healthy nation can be built if the citizens are physically fit. The mental pressure and tension arising out of the fast modern life can only be released in the playground and therefore, healthy diet and fitness have gained a new status in today's world.

Physical Education and participation in games and co-curricular activities are a compulsory part of every student's education and parents are expected to extend all co-operations in this regard. Maximum participation is expected from every student and exception will be made only for those who are physically unable to participate. In such cases, proper medical certificate should be submitted by the parents.

All team games (Basketball, Football, Volley ball, Cricket, Hand ball, Kho Kho etc) are played from the primary level and expert coaching is provided. Students are encouraged to participate in indoor and outdoor games and athletics. Students who are selected in the school team must report for coaching whenever called. Irregularity of attendance will lead to disciplinary action being taken against the student. To maintain a high standard of performance regular tournaments are conducted in all games. Students who maintain a high standard of performance are suitably rewarded and they are encouraged to participate at the State and National levels.

In CSJMU the faculties always participate in student activities to make overall development possible in the student community. Our Sports complex is well equipped with all necessary infrastructural facilities for indoor and outdoor sports.

All event of Athletics (100 m race, 200 m race, 400 m race, 800 m etc.), jumps (long jump, high jump, hop step & jump etc.) and throws (javelin throw, discuss throw, shot put etc.) must be conducted every year. Athletics competitions have to be held in during the period of December to February. Best performers of Intra-Faculty competitions represent the Faculty at the Institute level. The winners should be awarded by prizes on the annual sports day.
