Revision of the Syllabus

Preamble

The Chhatrapati Shahu Ji Maharaj University (formerly Kanpur University), Kanpur was established in the year 1966 to impart and promote multi- and interdisciplinary higher education by utilizing the modern concepts of teaching and research at bachelors, masters and doctoral level. Since then it has been the light house for higher education through its more than 650 affiliated colleges spread over 15 districts of Uttar Pradesh and more than 4.5 lakh students on its roll and offers unparalleled range of courses in all disciplines of Arts, Science, Commerce, Law, Engineering, Biotechnology, Computer Applications, Management and Medicine.

In an effort to cater to the students' needs at par with global demands, the University is utilizing its special facilities to offer socially relevant, professional, technical and job oriented courses and has been keenly introducing qualitative changes during the past years so as to gradually evolve into a distinctive teaching and research centre.

Policy on Syllabus Revision:

Syllabi are important documents that specify the expectations and responsibilities of faculty and students with respect to a given course, constituting an enforceable agreement.

Prior to the end of the drop/add period, faculty shall disseminate to each class section the following information:

- a. A course description and statement of course objectives
- b. The proposed topical outline (program scheme), where appropriate
- c. Course requirements (e.g., readings, research group work, presentations)
- d. The criteria and procedures for evaluating student performance including the availability of a pass/no credit option
- e. The attendance policy, within the parameters of the existing University policy
- f. Additional departmental or instructor policies as well as appropriate University-wide policies

Chhatrapati Shahu Ji Maharaj University is following National Education Policy-2020 for revision of syllabus at the graduate and post graduate level. Syllabi must contain a section on Programme Objective. Each course in every semester must contain measurable Course Objectives adhering to our constitutional goals.

The University has Choice Based Credit System for the courses running in the University. We maintain revising 20% of the syllabus in five years. The revision is based on the learning-Outcome based framework. Attempts are made to introduce recent updates, interdisciplinary / multi-disciplinary elective papers related to subject specialization. Additionally, attempts are being made to incorporate Indian knowledge system into the course curriculum. All of the revised syllabi are available on the website of the University.

Syllabus is revised by the convener of the subject by conducting a Board of Studies meeting with the experts from outside the University. The minutes of the meeting are submitted to the Dean Academics office which then is uploaded on the website of the University.
