HOST VENUE AND DESTINATION



Of all the factors influencing the sustainability of an event, destination and site selection play two of the most significant roles towards helping manage and mitigate our environmental impacts.

Venue of the Event: ABVSLS, CSJMU, Kanpur is located about 10 km away (~30 min) from Railway Station which **has direct connectivity** with most of the cities and about 20 km away (~ 45 min) Airport.

Accommodation: International Center located inside CSJM university campus and it is at a walking distance from the venue



EMISSION BY TRAVEL

1.5 metric tons CO₂ Emission by Air

0.9 metric tons CO₂ Emission by Train

0.6 metric tons of CO₂ Emission by Car & Bus



The projected CO₂ emissions for a group of **13 participants** flying a distance of 6,600 km is around 1539 Kg , which is equivalent to **1.5 metric tons of CO₂**(90 g per student-km).

The projected CO₂ emissions for a group of **44 participants** travels by Train distance of 123535 kms is around 965Kg, which is equivalent to **1 metric tons of CO₂**(avg. 41 g per student-km).

The projected CO₂ emissions for a group of **17 participant** traveling by bus over distances of 1200 km and 1400 km by car is roughly 597 kg. This translates to about **0.6 metric tons of CO₂** (avg. 80 grams per student-kilometer for the bus and 192 grams per student-kilometer for the car).

WASTE MANAGEMENT

Color coded bins: Event venue is equipped with color coded bins to collect different categories of the waste

Composting: Event venue is equipped in-house organic waste composting machine to compost the waste generated.

Waste water treatment: Event venue is equipped with 1.1 MLD treatment plant to reuse the wastewater.

Conference-Kit: Bags and Kitbags provided to the delegates and participants is made up of recycled materials and jute



ENERGY CONSUMPTION

Energy and Water are extensively utilized during the event and sustainability of an event is hugely dependent on managing these resources efficiently

Solar Panels: ABVSLS, CSJMU campus is equipped with 2 MWp of roof-top on grid solar panels to harness the renewable source of energy.

Occupancy sensors and motion sensor-based led lights are installed in some of the buildings.

WATER CONSUMPTION



Water is extensively utilized during the event and sustainability of an event is hugely dependent on managing this precious resources efficiently

IoT based smart water metering: Event venue is equipped with IoT based smart water monitoring to monitor and optimize the water consumption

Water bottles: Refillable stainless steel water bottles for guests. Also participants are encouraged to carry their water bottles

Rainwater Harvesting: Event venue is equipped with roof top rain water system to recharge the precious groundwater resource.
